# Beaches

# Southeast



### Caló d'es Moro

Is an incredibly beautiful beach situated deep inside a bay with sheer cliffs. It is a small beach, but the 40 metres of beach is covered with fine-grained and bright sand. The water is crystal clear with the most beautiful turquoise shades. When you have parked your car, there is a few hundred metres on foot. You will pass the beach Cala s'Almuniaon the way, but Calo des Moro is the most beautiful one of the two. There is a steep flight of stairs down to Calo des Moro and it has no facilities – not even close to the beach. For many years, the beach has been described as a ' secret tip'.



### Cala Varques

Due to its remote Tocation on a stretch of coast that is hard to access, the charming rocky bay with its fine sandy beach is something of an insider secret.



Cala en Tugores
The unspoilt beach of Cala en Tugores lies in the middle of wonderful natural scenery. At the end of U-shaped cove with crystal-clear water, you will find this oasis of peace and seclusion. To reach the beach from Colonia de Sant Jordi, you must first walk about six kilometres.



Cala Figuera
This fairytale beach in the so-called "Bay of Figs" is not a beach in the real sense of the word. Stone tracks through the cliffs lead to boat piers along both sides of the bay. Visitors will enjoy ambling around the port and the coast on foot, perhaps before dining in one of the several restaurants here. The small village, which shares its name with the beach, is also worth a visit.



#### Cala s'Almunia

Cala s'Almunia is a very small town consisting of just 30-40 houses. It is incredibly beautifully situated in a rocky bay surrounded by pine trees. The small beach is just 10 meters long and 30 meters wide.

# Beaches

### Southwest



#### S'Amarador

is one of two beautiful beaches in the Cala Mondrago nature reserve on the south eastern coastof Mallorca. The beach is surrounded by tall pine trees and the view is stunning. Is 145 metres long and 50 metres wide with fine, white sand and clear, shallow water.



#### Cala Fornells

Overhanging pine trees offer areas of natural shade and add to the overall charm of the cove. The beach doesn't have a life guard, toilet or showers and there is no wheelchair access.



#### Cala Llombards

a magical bay on the rugged coast. Steep cliffs enclose the fjord-like bay, which extends about 230 m inland. The beach at the end of the bay is only 55 m long and up to SOUTHWEST 150 m wide.

# Northeast



#### Son Serra de Marina

The beach is 450 metres long and is very deep, at 130 metres. It backs on to natural sand dunes and countryside -no built up coastline here. There aren't any sun loungers to hire here, in fact the only service you'll find are showers. However, there is a beach bar/restaurant called El Sol which should need all your refreshment needs.



### Cala Ratjada

The <u>beaches in Cala Ratjada</u> are very popular because of their fine golden sand and crystal clear turquoise seas, ideal for soaking up the sun. You can also enjoy <u>many watersports</u> such as diving, water skiing, windsurfing and sailing. The main beach is Son Moll, located to the south of the harbour; it is 150 metres long (50 metres deep) and can get very busy during the summer months. The smaller beach of Cala Gat, to the east of the harbour, is equally popular. Other, quieter beaches can be found further north – try Cala Agulla or Cala Mesquida

### Northwest



#### Sa Calobra

the beach is situated between the cliffs where the canyon Torrent de Pareis reaches the sea. Situated in absolutely stunning surroundings.



#### Cala Tuent

Cala Tuent is located in the most beautiful natural surroundings with a view of the highest mountain in Mallorca, Puig Major, with an altitude of 1,445 metres. The beach is 100 metres long and situated inside a lovely bay surrounded by the wooded Tramuntana mountains. The sand is mixed with gravel and pebbles, also in the clean and completely clear water, which makes bathing shoes a wise choice. BEWARE OF JELLYFISH



### Playa de Formentor

Cala Formentor is one of the finest natural beaches in Mallorca, surrounded by woods and the Tramuntana mountains. The beach is almost one kilometre long, however, it is quite narrow. The sand is fine-grained and bright. The water is very clear and has beautiful turquoise shades. There is a large parking place with shade for your car



### Cala Torta

It is about 130 m long and has fine, white sand. Is not possible to hire beach umbrellas, you should bring your own parasol to protect yourself from the sun.



# Cala Agulla

After you have crossed a pine forest, you reach a large pay car park. This is the point to leave your hire car and from here take one of the many paths to the beach.



### Playa s'Illot

Is a beautiful sea-washed bay set to a backdrop of a scattering of small boulders. For added scenic appeal it is close to an islet that may tempt you to pay a visit. There are rocky areas that, having been shaped by wind and sea, offer a safe and attractive backdrop to your stay.

# Sunset Spots



### Faro des Cap Blanc

You can't enter this lighthouse at Cap Blanc, which dates to 1863 with a light-beam that was originally fuelled by olive oil. But you can approach the gate and wander through gaps in the fence by the road to explore the surrounding rugged coastline. From here, the views along the ruddy cliff-face, with Palma and the western mountains in one direction, the Illa de Cabrera in the other, and seabirds circling the Mediterranean sky overhead, are nothing short of breathtaking.



### Mirador de Sa Torre

We find high cliffs and fantastic views of the bay of Palma with that beautiful blue of the Mediterranean Sea. If there is a special place, it is the viewpoint of Sa Torre, a splendid place to enjoy a beautiful sunset. It is also not very crowded, and it is easy to park.



# Torre del Verger

The Torre del Verger watchtower, built in the Middle Ages, stands on a rocky promontory on the northwest coast of Mallorca in the municipality of Banyalbufar and is located approximately one kilometre from the town of the same name. At this point, the foothills of the Serra de Tramontana slope steeply down to the sea.

#### Mirador es Colomer

It is one of the island's best sightseeing, hiking, and viewing spots. It is located up in the dramatic Sierra Tramuntana mountain range near Puerto Pollensa. 

Fornalutx is a village with just 700 souls in the Serra de Tramuntana in the north of Mallorca. With its narrow winding lanes, stone houses and stone steps, the place is an architectural jewel on the west coast of Mallorca. Fornalutx has been named the "most beautiful village in Spain" twice in recent history.

### Northeast



#### Artà

sits against the dramatic backdrop of the rolling Serres de Llevantmountains. The town is a maze of steep alleys and streets that lead up to the hill top chapel of Santuari de Sant Salvador. It's worth the climb up for the panoramic views of the east and its gentle mountain range.

### West



# Banyalbufar

one of the last authentic coastal village in Mallorca located on a steep hillside at the edge of the Tramuntana mountain range. Its ancient terraced hillsides descending down to the sea is a must see, as well as glorious views of the Tramuntana mountains and amazing sunsets.



### Puigpunyent

a small village very close to Palma where enjoy a rural escape with tranquility offered by the surroundings. Do not miss Visit La Reserva Puig de Galatzó a natural park with 2.5 million meters of unspoilt countryside. Many options of cycling and hiking at the mountains nearby.

# Museums



Joan March Foundation: This corner of Palma is synonymous with modernity. Its entrance and marvellous staircase will amaze you; you cannot help but enter into one of Palma's magical universes.



Es Baluard Museum: As a referent in the Balearic Islands of the artistic creation in the 20th and 21th centuries, Es Baluard Museu d'Art Contemporani de Palma presents differents views of its collection, organizes exhibitions of the main international artists and promotes languages as music, theater, performance, poetry and circus, in the context of the experimental movements

**Museum of Mallorca:** The Museum of Mallorca is a splendid art space inside a fabulous large house commonly known as "Ca la Gran Cristiana".


# Museums



# July




**Inca Jazz Festival:** There are generally four Jazz evenings, each taking place in the Claustre de Sant Domingo. Entrance is free.


# August


